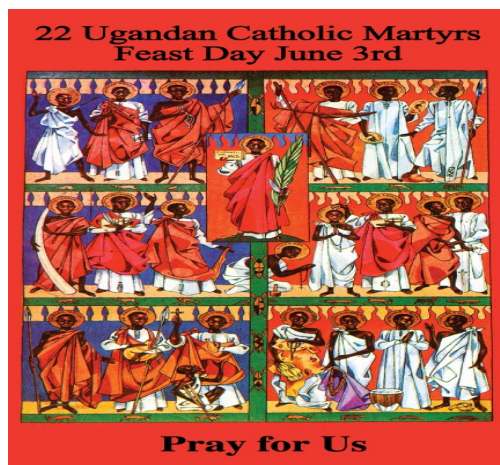


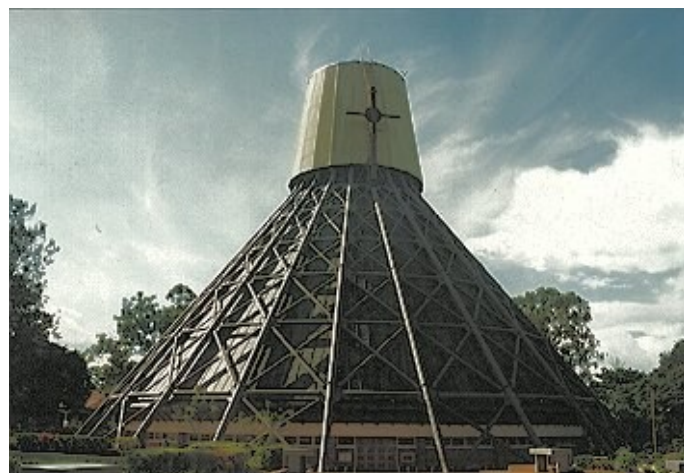

This year the Ugandan Martyrs Feast day falls on the Feast of the Blessed Trinity. This is surely good news for the preacher at his Sunday Masses. Our daily newspaper go much more for the martyrs death than baby's births; do gooders or an article on the Holy Trinity. Sometimes the story of King Mwanga of Uganda reads better than the martyrs. This king hated religion and all involved. But Jesus spoke kindly of those who suffered.—'Blessed are you when people abuse you and persecute you and speak all kinds of calumny against you on my account. Your reward will be great.' (**Matthew 5:11-12**)

Many Christians/Catholics see the Trinity doctrine as a complicated mystery and some are inclined towards something akin to 3 gods. Some are Unitarians keeping it simple — "Oh I only speak to God our Father", Jesus is just for some a special man who reveals the Father and the Holy Spirit is a power rather than a Divine Person.

For me the Trinity is simply a **community of love**, constantly in motion. It is the central mystery of our Christian Faith and Life. This mystery cannot be understood by reasons alone. It needs faith in the one who reveals God Himself.

The Father holds and keeps all creation, us included, in his embrace. Jesus is God's living image and Word of the Father and the Holy Spirit is the power and presence of Jesus in each one of us helping and guiding us.

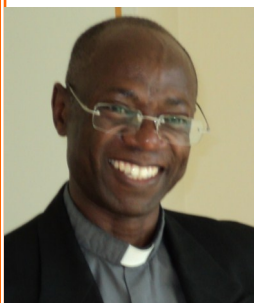
The Trinity is an image to show us how to relate to one another and to all creation. 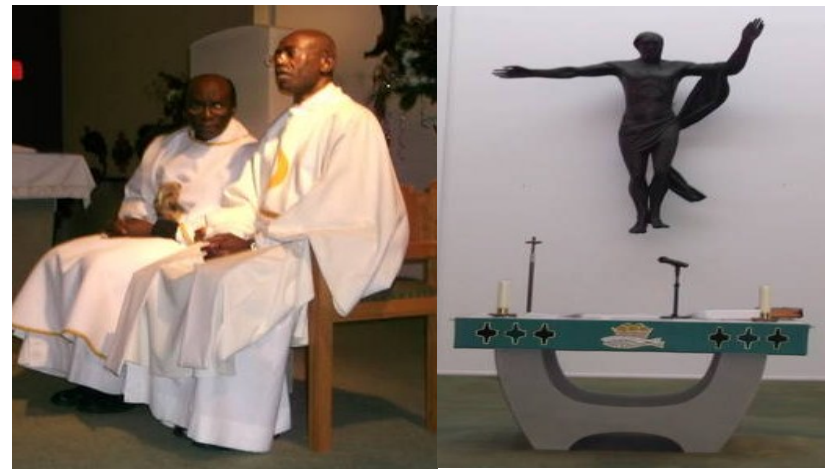

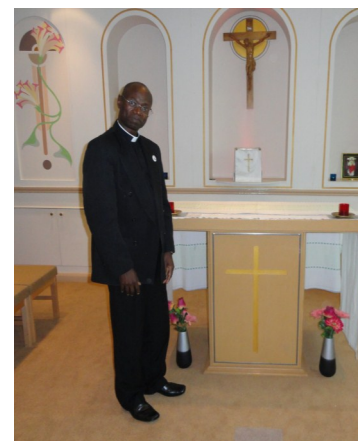
