CHAPLAIN'S MESSAGE

INCLUSION, INCLUSION IN JESUS' NAME

Dear Brethren,

Human beings, animals, birds and many other creatures have an instinct to live together in "communities". You will find a flock of birds, sheep, or a herd of cattle, etc. together. You will come across a pack of wolves! It is in nature that living things tend to live together. They want to belong to a community or a society especially in case of human beings. They will often be suspicious of foreigners in their midst and would do anything to prevent any intrusion.

In today's gospel we hear the disciples concerned about people outside Jesus' circle who were prophesying. They wanted Jesus to stop them from performing exorcisms in his name. Jesus replied that such people should not be stopped as long as they did it in good faith, in his name. Jesus was trying to broaden the outlook of his disciples who were tempted to seal themselves off as a closed exclusive group. Jesus is very inclusive. His focus is not on exclusive clubs but on faith.

The first reading reiterates the same message when Moses says: "Would that all the Lord's people were prophets, that the Lord would put his spirit upon them." This is a desire for openness and a reminder that all the baptized people are in some sense priests, prophets and kings.

May the Lord grant us a spirit of openness to see the goodness of other people who do not belong to our team, our club, our church,/religion/faith, our race, our tribe, our colour and you name it. God bless you all.
