CHAPLAIN'S MESSAGE

THE GREATEST COMMANDMENT

Dear Brethren in Christ,

Families have routines and a set of values to guide their lives. Associations, organizations, institutions, communities and nations all have their sets of laws, rules, regulations, policies and constitutions to guide them towards fulfilling their mission, objectives and goals.

During the Old Testament times God's people were guided by the Laws and the Prophets. When Christ came he said he had come to fulfil them by giving them a new perspective and a fresh approach. In today's Gospel, one of the Pharisees posed a question to trap him: 'Master, which is the greatest commandment of the Law?' His answer: 'You must love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind...you must love your neighbour as yourself' (**Matthew 22:37-39**). This law is core to Christianity and it is untouchable! No one is allowed to tamper with it because it governs the existence and life of the church and its members.

Loving God with all our heart, soul, mind and strength means 'wholehearted service, attention and obedience'. God must come first before anything else. It is so demanding because we have to use or apply everything we have and are to love and serve God.

Loving the neighbour is another challenge. This can be expressed through our sharing with, concern for and support to others in need without expecting any reward. This is unconditional love and service which sometimes involves going the extra mile. Thus, politics and social work should be inspired by love of neighbour. Any service excluding the welfare of the neighbour is contrary to the spirit of the Gospel. God bless you all.

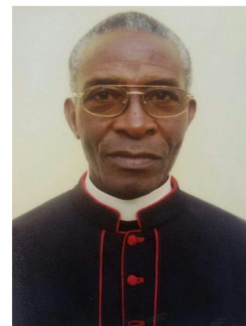

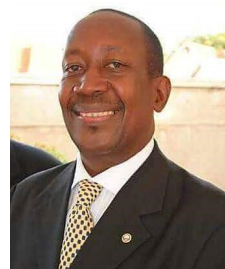
